> School prioritises welcome and empathy and celebrates the contribution of different cultures to the school and community through events & initiatives

School communicates its dedication to being a School of Sanctuary and ensures that SoSI info is displayed prominently in school & referred to at school events Students and staff develop and practise intercultural awareness and skills; students and families are supported with EAL needs

The school develops a portfolio to reflect their actions & engagement with the Sanctuary Principles-Learn, Action and Share
